#### Week 3 (July 9 - 13) Soaring Science with HighTouch HighTech

- Tuesday, July 10 Salty Science! Campers get to work with this amazing chemical compound. They'll do a little ice-cube fishing and use salt to grow their own salt crystal garden.
- Thursday, July 12 Kitchen Chemistry! Campers will never look at their kitchens the same way after this program. They will have a blast as they make sidewalk chalk and a fireworks display in a bowl of...milk??

#### Week 4 (July 16 - 20) Outrageous Animal Adventures

- Tuesday, July 17 Lizards and Turtles and Snakes, Oh My! The Reptile Family will provide our campers with an interactive, hands-on experience with a myriad of reptiles and one or two special animal guests. Our campers will learn about the animals' habitats, diet, and conservation.

- Thursday, July 19 Conservation and Preservation! The Nature of Wildworks will bring a variety of animals, mostly species native to California, who are being cared for by the organization. Our campers will learn about what they can do to help protect and preserve these animals' native habitats while getting a chance to visit with these animals in an up close and personal way.

Friday, July 20 - At Home In The Sea presented by the Cabrillo Marine Aquarium! Sea stars, urchins, lobsters and crabs are just some of the sea animals highlighted in this fun and interactive hands-on class! Our campers will dive into an ocean of discovery and touch some strange, slippery, slimy and LIVE ocean creatures that make the tidepools their home.

#### Week 5 (July 23 - 27) Music Motion with Miss Sarah

- Monday, July 23 Musical Parachute! We will play a wide variety of musical games which will focus on music theory, listening, and movement.
- Wednesday, July 25 Create your own Musical Masterpiece! We will use icons and symbols to form a musical composition which we will collectively, as a group, play at the end of the activity!
- Friday, July 27 Make your own Instrument! We will be using a number of materials to create guitars, drums, shakers, and more! After the instruments are completed, we will play a few activities together with our new instruments!

#### Week 6 (July 30 - Aug 3) Flying Culinary Creations with Miss Christa

- Tuesday, July 31 Super Heroes! Do you have super powers? Come join us and test your food IQ. Do you know what foods make you have better eye sight? Build muscle? Strengthen your teeth and bones? Have a super hero food party with us and try all our super hero foods that make our bodies extra strong. Make fruit pops and take your favorite superfoods home to share with parents.
- Wednesday, Aug 1 Hot Air Balloons! Yeast is that cool ingredient that makes foods rise and fill up with air. Find out how this amazing living food works. Campers will look at all sorts of foods that have yeast. Touch and feel yeasted dough and roll and paint balls for our hot air balloons. After they cook, campers will enjoy their yummy treat!


